Issues of Advocacy in High Profile, Complex, Media-saturated Criminal Cases

During his almost four-decade career, Mr. Bayne has navigated some of the more complex waters in modern Canadian legal history: murder, war crimes, and extradition. He has acted in high-profile inquiries, including the 1993 Somalia military scandal, and the case of Maher Arar, the Canadian-Syrian engineer arrested in New York in 2002 and tortured in Syria. Mr. Bayne was awarded the prestigious G. Arthur Martin award in 2006 for "an individual in Canada who has made a significant contribution to criminal justice." He is the only Ottawa lawyer to receive the honour, which in the legal profession is roughly akin to winning an Academy Award.
